



Bruce Craig Fellowship Application 2014

Each year, depending on the funds available, MAAM awards up to six fellowships to the Annual Meeting. The purpose of the Fellowship is to make attendance at the Annual Meeting affordable to promising graduate students and emerging professionals. In honor of Bruce Craig, the Mid-Atlantic Association of Museums has named the Annual Conference Fellowships in his honor. We hope that the museum profession will honor the legacy of Bruce through the support of this and future classes of fellowship recipients. Bruce Craig, Director of Research in the Smithsonian Center for Education and Museum Studies (SCEMS), passed away on March 9, 2010, after a brief illness.

Eligibility

First time Museum professionals (having less than five years of paid experience in the field) and graduate students currently enrolled or having graduated in the last year from a graduate school program in Museum Studies, Museum Education, Public History or a related area of study (e.g. Museum Exhibition) located in the MAAM Region who have not previously attended a MAAM Annual Meeting.

Each Fellow receives:

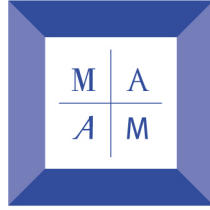
- \$500 which can be applied towards transportation, lodging, and meals.

- An Essay (no longer than 500 words) answering, "How would attendance at this year's Mid-Atlantic of Museums conference benefit your career?"
