Deputy Director (half-time)

The nonprofit National Food Museum seeks an entrepreneurial, part-time Deputy Director to help lead our young organization as we enter an exciting stage of development. This position offers a unique opportunity to shape a new national institution devoted to the history, culture, and future of food in America. A special emphasis is the impact of diet on health and the environment/climate.

Working closely with the founding board of directors, the Deputy Director will guide strategic planning, fundraising, and program development to build a sustainable foundation for the museum.

We seek a leader who understands both the artistry and the infrastructure of building an institution—someone who can connect with partners across the food, agriculture, and cultural sectors; cultivate donors and sponsors; and help raise the museum's visibility nationally.

Responsibilities include shaping and implementing the museum's operational and fundraising strategies, managing relationships with donors and collaborators, overseeing early program initiatives (both digital and in-person), and guiding brand development and public outreach.

Ideally, candidates for this half-time position will live in the Washington, DC, area, though the work could be performed virtually. The role will evolve as the museum grows, with potential for expanded hours and leadership opportunities as funding expands. The salary will be \$60,000-\$70,000 per year.
